Hall of Honor 15th Anniversary. Wayne, Barbara, and Sandi meet with Stephanie Stephens, CPRS Executive Director and Jim Wheeler, President of California Foundation for Parks and Recreation (CFPR) to discuss the Hall of Honor and how we might encourage other Districts and/or Regions in the State to consider similar programs to honor and memorialize legacy accomplishments in their areas.

At the meeting Stephanie offered a “handful of tables” at the CPRS Conference in Sacramento (March 8-11, 2022) in the Exhibit Hall to provide information about the Hall of Honor. She also offered passes to the Exhibit Hall which we can distribute to Hall of Honor inductees.
