The Partnership for Quality Living DRAFT Minutes January 18, 2023

Chair Wayne Lowery called the Partnership for Quality Living ("PQL") meeting to order at 10:10 am at the Cordova Recreation & Park District, Paul Hagan Community Center. Also present were Leslie Fritz, Claudia Goss, Sandi Kukkola, Ashika Lal, Kathy Martinez, Judy Quattrin, Debby Walker, Ward Winchell, and Rena Wood. <u>Welcome and introduction</u> – Kathy Martinez, introduced herself and explained her background in Corrections with the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department and as a Professor at CSUS. It was also noted that this is Rena's first in person meeting.

<u>Minutes</u> – The minutes of November 16, 2022, were approved by general Consent.

Wayne suggested <u>Charlie Willard</u> be appointed as an emeritus member. Debby moved and Judy seconded the motion. Approved. Wayne will send a letter to Charlie, thanking him for his service.

<u>Finance Report</u> - The Sacramento Parks Foundation received three donations toward the end of the year. The current balance in the Sacramento Parks Foundation fund is \$3,133.

<u>Election of Officers and Appointment of Chairs</u> – Wayne will continue to chair the meeting until a new Chair is appointed. Debby volunteered to serve as Finance Officer, Sandi moved, Judy seconded the motion. Approved. Wayne notified Ashika that Debby is now the PQL Finance Officer.

<u>Website</u> – Claudia received input from committee members regarding the memo she sent. It is the consensus that we move forward with a website refresh. She will talk to Barry about the current website. Claudia hopes to launch the refreshed website in the spring. She recommends staying with a free website.

<u>Hall of Honor Nomination Brochure</u> – The nomination committee will meet on January 23, noon at Brookfield's in Rancho Cordova and report back at the February meeting. It is recommended that a 5' x 7' or similar size post card be mailed to announce the nomination process. The post card could also be distributed at the D2 Banquet and the CPRS Conference Region 1 social in San Diego.

<u>New Board Members</u> – Kathy reached out to an individual in Recreation Therapy who may be interested in serving on the committee. He is highly energetic and would be a good addition.

Committee Reports –

Hall of Honor:

- Leslie created a Google Docs online form for the Hall of Honor Nominations. Short and conscience answers are required. Photos and letters of recommendation may be emailed.
- She will set up a pilot program for committee members to give input. Debby suggested that we model the application process after the District 2 Awards Program. District 2 hopes to migrate from PDF to Google Forms later this year.

 individuals should begin soon. Wayne will call Barry to start discussions and to obtain the HOH
 window clings which Barry ordered last year. Kathy stated research on area Parks could be

- conducted by students through the independent study program. Jonathan Korfhage recently published a book on the History of Parks and Recreation in California. The book could be used as a resource. Kathy is interested in working with Barry on the Archival Committee. Rena is also interested in serving on this committee.
